

Alaska Health Insurance Premium Payment Program

More Coverage, No Extra Cost



Get more health coverage at no extra cost, with the Alaska Health Insurance Premium Payment Program (HIPP). Alaska HIPP, sponsored by Alaska's Department of Health, makes healthcare more affordable for Medicaid recipients and their families by reimbursing the cost of monthly premiums paid for group health insurance coverage.

To prequalify for the HIPP program, an applicant must be eligible for Medicaid within the state of Alaska and must have access to group health insurance that is offered through an employer or COBRA. Individuals may apply for HIPP at any time of the year, even outside of the employer's open enrollment period.

Alaska HIPP is administered by Medicaid's contractor, HMS — a Gainwell Technologies company.

How to Apply

1. Apply online or print the HIPP application to fill out at <https://www.myakhipp.com>
2. Obtain the following required documents:
 - Health insurance rate sheet that includes information such as the "Individual Only," "Individual + Spouse," "Individual + Child" or "Family" premium amounts
 - Benefit plan summary that includes information such as the deductible and out-of-pocket amounts
 - Proof of health insurance payment (if you're already covered)
 - Copy of your medical, dental and vision insurance card (if you're already covered)
